

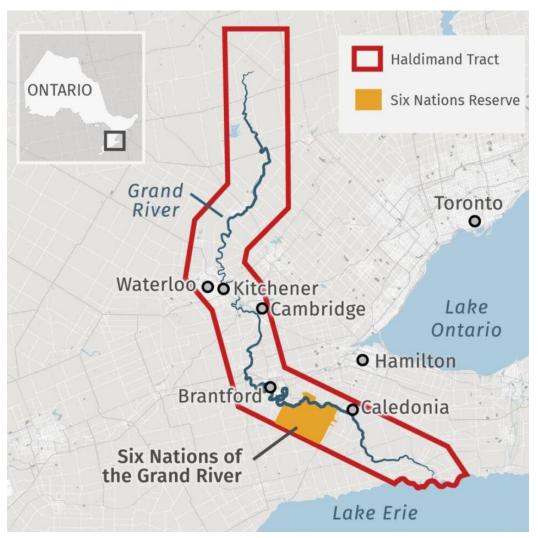

The Haldimand Treaty promised a tract of 6 miles of land on either side of the Grand River to the Six Nations of the Grand River.

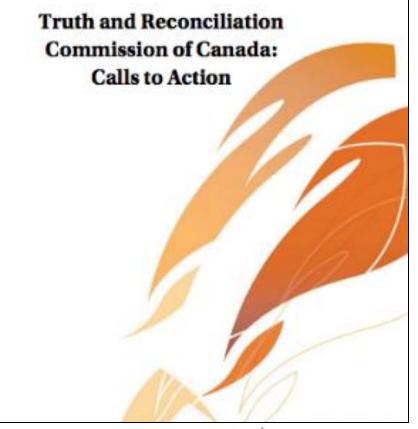
